

## The Andrews Scholarships

The Andrews Scholarships exist to provide financial support for undergraduate students of Civil and Mechanical Engineering at the University of Manchester.

### Regulations

- A. An award of an amount of up to £5,000 per annum will be offered to UK students studying (or applying to study) an undergraduate programme in the School of Mechanical, Aerospace and Civil Engineering (MACE) at the University of Manchester.
- B. The scholarship will be available to students studying any undergraduate degree programme in Civil or Mechanical Engineering.
- C. The scholarship will normally be tenable for the duration of the student's programme of study subject to satisfactory academic progress and the receipt of an annual written update from the student.
- D. Scholarship holders will be selected against a number of qualifying criteria with preference given to students who can demonstrate some or all of the following:
  - a. Academic excellence – based on A-level results (or equivalent entry qualifications)
  - b. Residence within the Greater Manchester region
  - c. Financial need – students with a low household income who would find undertaking study at the University difficult without additional financial assistance
  - d. A commitment to the field of Civil or Mechanical Engineering
